

STUDENT MINISTRY SCHOLARSHIP FUND APPLICATION

The Student Ministry Scholarship Fund (the “Fund”) exists to financially assist with the tuition and course-related expenses of students who:

- (1) are members in good standing of King of Kings;
- (2) have graduated from high school (or will soon graduate, in the case of high school seniors who apply);
- (3) attend or will attend Christian schooling/training with the purpose of entering full-time vocational church work upon completion of the schooling/training.

Christian schooling/training is broadly defined to include degree and non-degree programs and synodical and non-synodical schools/training institutions that are not inconsistent with the mission, vision and values of King of Kings. Church work is defined at the discretion of the Committee administering the Fund, and examples of vocations that qualify as church work for purposes of the Fund include pastors, church workers, para-church professionals, teachers at Christian schools and missionaries.

- A type-written essay describing the following: (1) the current status of your relationship with God, how you plan to grow and stay connected with Him; (2) why you chose to attend the schooling/training mentioned above; (3) what your plans are for entering full-time vocational church work upon completion of the schooling/training; and (4) any other information you think is pertinent to your Application. A full explanation of each of the above is required but there is no specific page limit for the essay.
- *In the case of first-time applicants only*, two current letters of reference written by persons not related to you, and one of the references must be written by a faculty member of the institution you attend (for those of you just graduating from high school, a reference from a high school teacher will suffice; a non-traditional student just reentering schooling/training can submit references from people known from a work experience, a pastor, etc.).
- *In the case of first-time applicants only*, a school transcript showing your grades (may not apply to “non-traditional” students) from the previous year of schooling/training.
- *All applicants*, a digital photo emailed to heatherk@kingofkingsomaha.org (does not need to be a formal photo).
